



Rules for the Jumps Ahead Competition 2021.

All stages will take place in the Sand Arena in **Ballindenisk, T56 YX60**

HORSES/PONIES

- Five years of age or older of any height – must be regularly pony clubbed. No stallions.
- Registered with SJI or EI allowed – see height rule below.
- Ponies and horses are eligible to enter competition heights within 20cm of the highest SJI/IPC/EI competition entered either this year or in the previous calendar year. For example, if they have entered and jumped a 1.10-metre class or higher on any occasion, they may enter the 90cm class but are not eligible for the 80cm class.

RIDERS

Riders must be current members of any branch of the Irish Pony Club and must have attended three branch rallies to compete. Note: each qualifier can count as a rally – therefore, after three (out of competition) qualifiers a member can compete in the final. The DC of each branch will be asked to confirm the eligibility of their qualified members.

COMPETITION HEIGHTS

- New for 2021 – non-competitive/clear round starter stakes class (50s)
- Six Competitive Qualifier Classes - 60cm, 70cm, 80cm, 90cm, 1m, 1.10m
- Height of fences may rise 5cm for final.
- An optional Joker Fence will be included in all classes.
- If Joker is attempted and cleared, 5 seconds are taken from the actual time. If Joker is attempted and failed, 5 seconds is added to actual time.

COMPETITION DATES – all on Sand at Ballindenisk (T56 YX60)

- 3 Qualifying competitions to be held on
Sunday, October 17th; Sunday, October 31st; Sunday, November 14th
- Final – **Sunday, November 28th**

ENTRY FEES (In Advance via Muskerry Pony Club ItsPlainSailing page)

Entry Fees for all classes: €22.00

(Entries close at Midnight on the Wednesday before each competition)

Ponies/Horses must be entered using their Passport Names.

PRIZES

Rosettes 1 to 6 at Qualifiers. Rosettes 1 to 6 at Final.

Prizes 1 to 6 at Final for winners of each class on the day.

Prizes at Final for League winner in each class

Prizes at Final for Best Turned Out in each class (Sponsored by **Delforno Tiles & Timber**)

Note – Starter Stakes is a clear round class and does not qualify for league points

COMPETITION RULES

- All rules subject to change at the organiser's discretion
- Qualifiers are 2 phase - jumps 1-14+ Joker. – jumps 1-8 are not timed – but jumps 1-8 must be clear – timer starts from a Point between jump 8 and 9. Jump 15 is the joker fence. Qualifiers will run under Article 274 (2 phase)
- Final run under Article 238 2.2
(2 round class, both rounds timed, 2nd round against the clock))
- **Entries via ItsPlainSailing in Advance and all competitors will be given jump times.**
- **You MUST jump at your Jump time and adhere to the instructions of all Stewards.**
- Participation (irrespective of result) in two qualifiers will allow entry to the Final.
- A combination can compete/qualify in two competitions, but the competitions must be consecutive, i.e. can compete/qualify in 60cm and 70cm but can't compete/qualify in both 60cm and 80cm. Competitors can compete again on a different pony/horse
- Competitors must comply with the IPC Show Jumping tack sheet. There will be a tack inspection on the day.
- C test standard required for 90cm class and above. Where C test not achieved, DC can vouch for ability.
- Please Note – Organisers reserve the right to cancel any class or whole competition. Refunds will be issued in this case.

LEAGUE

- There will be a prize for the combination with the most league points at the end of the league. (League points are awarded at each qualifier and the final. Points from 1st – 6th place and for a double clear. So all four events count)

1st Place	10
2 nd Place	9
3 rd Place	8
4 th Place	7
5 th Place	6
6 th Place	5
Double Clear	4
